October's Special Treat is the first three steps in Managing and Organizing your photos. Watch in November and December as we provide steps 4-6 and 7-10. Then, by January 2024, you will have all ten steps ready to start Managing and Organizing your photos in 2024.

1. Getting your photos organized starts with having everything in one place. The prints are some

times easier than finding all the digital images, but start with what you can find, and every time

you find more, bring them to that ONE place.

2. Look at the type and condition of your old photo albums. Not all albums are safe for your

photos. Those "magnetic" albums are some of the worst as they have both acid and chemicals in

the plastic that fade and destroy printed photos. Get your photos out of those ASAP! To

remember the order and arrangement of the album, take a photo or scan each page beforehand.

3. As you are sorting your photos, use the ABC'S to help you move along.

- A. Photos to go in an album.
- B. Photos to keep in a box (storage).
- C. Photos to toss in the trash can or delete.
- S. Photos that tell a story or have a high priority of being scanned.
