November's Gift that Keeps on Giving

In October, we provided the first 3 steps to Managing and Organizing your photos. If you need a reminder, I have included the recap here: 1. Please gather your pictures in one place. 2. Get your pictures out of the magnetic albums ASAP. 3 The ABC'S.

Now, here in November, are steps 4 through 6.

4. What are the themes that keep popping up in your photos? Sort either by themes or events. It can be enjoyable to see how people change over time while looking at a recurring event in your family.

5. Remember to have other people look at your photos with you when working with your photos. You never know what they might remember about the photo you forgot or didn't know. Even your kids will have stories that should be captured and could be different than what you might tell.

6. Start sorting by eliminating the duplicates, out-of-focus, dark, or otherwise bad photos. Use the DELETE key for digital images and the trash can for prints. The only time to keep one of these is if there's a story behind it and no other photo tells that same story. You can only give the duplicates in the photo to others if you hand them off.

In December, we provide steps 7-10. Then, by January 2024, you will have all ten steps ready to start Managing and Organizing your photos in 2024.
