#### **December's Gift that Keeps on Giving**

In October and November, we provided the 6 steps to Managing and Organizing your photos. If you need a reminder, I have included the recap here: 1. Please be sure to gather your pictures in one place. 2. Get your pictures out of the magnetic albums ASAP. 3 The ABC'S. 4. What are the

themes? 5. Have other people look at your photos. 6. DELETE

Now, here in December, are steps 7 through 10.

- 7. The multiplying digital images on your computer calls for good photoorganizing software. It should allow you to tag photos with multiple tags, tell the story, view them chronologically, be searchable, and have some editing functions. You don't want multiple copies of the same photo on your computer.
- 8. Don't forget to backup. The recommendation is to have three digital copies and at least one printed hard copy (especially of your best photos). One is on your computer, one is on an external hard drive or flash drive, and one is offsite in the cloud.
- 9. Before you use an online photo site or backup company, the Terms of Service. You want to have your photos saved at full resolution and be able to get them back the same way.
- 10. Organize, Preserve, and Share your Memories, Photos, and Stories with your loved ones today.




#### The Craft Time Corner


